Dear Praying Family and Friends,

Wow, what a whirlwind of a month, thank you so much for your faithful prayers for us. God has been so good to us and we praise Him for the safety that He has provided on the road. We worked our way from the Dallas area to the Chicago area, down to Pensacola, and then back up to northern Mississippi, presenting in 8 different churches. We have had one new church notify us that they voted to take us on and that brings our support level to just over 57%, along with our start up fund continuing to grow, again praise the Lord!

In four of the churches we visited, we were part of their missions conference. One of the blessings of being in a missions conference is getting to meet other missionaries. Almost all of the missionary families that we met, we did not know prior to the conferences. I was really struck by the fact that God is strategically working to get the gospel to every country and all people. The great commission is such a large task that many times I think it is utterly impossible, but with God all things are possible, and it is exciting to be part of His master plan.

A couple of other praises from this month are: we have been able to be pretty consistent with homeschooling even with the heavy travel, we were also able to get some preventative maintenance done on the suburban and God gave wisdom to check several things before getting stranded, we were also encouraged by getting to spend some time with old friends we have not seen in years.

As we look at the month ahead of us we ask you to join us in praying that the Lord would continue to raise our support level. Our original goal was to be heading to the field in January, (and we know God is able to meet that goal if that is His timing), but we are scheduled for meetings through the first quarter of 2018 and are content to wait on his timing. Please continue praying for safety as we travel (we will be in 10 churches this month in MS, MD, PA, OH, KY, and IN), and for good health as we enter flu season. Also pray that the Lord would continue to use us to be an encouragement to the churches we visit. Our prayer is to be used of the Lord even while we are raising support.
