Dear Family and Friends,

Hello from Honduras! We are so excited to be here and have hit the ground running trying to get ourselves set up and unpacked. God has answered several specific prayer requests in miraculous ways just in the process of traveling to Honduras. I know that many of you have been praying for these things and God's provision is a direct answer to your prayers for us, thank you.

Our flight to Honduras left from Atlanta on May 29th and we arrived at the airport at about 5:20 to begin the process of checking our 32 pieces of luggage. God gave us great grace in the eyes of the ticket counter staff who initially told us that they could not waive our excess baggage fees but as they began checking the bags changed their mind and we were only required to pay \$780! Then as we made our way through TSA, God again provided grace in the eyes of the staff because 2 of our carryons were pulled because I had packed some wrenches and sockets to conserve on weight in our checked bags. The TSA Agent scolded me for packing these prohibited items and then gave them back to me and told me to pack them back into my carryons. Upon arriving in Honduras we were obviously the last ones from our flight to leave the baggage claim area which ended up being a blessing because the Customs screener was not at the x-ray machine when we got there. The men helping us, put all of our luggage on the conveyer belts and we collected it on the other side without anyone actually monitoring the scans!

We are quickly making our house a home and our appliances should be delivered on Monday. Please continue to pray that the Lord will help us to get emotionally settled quickly. We still need to purchase a vehicle, and we plan to start language school later this month.

We also want to praise the Lord for 2 new supporting churches, which brings us to 85%! We praise the Lord for our 55 supporting churches and 13 supporting individuals, and for all of you that support us through prayer. We trust that the Lord will continue to provide the financial partners for the remainder of our support goal. Thank you again for all of your love and prayers.
